



CLUB MARQUEE AT RMA SANDHURST CHARITY POLO DAY on THURSDAY 7th JULY 2011

The Royal Military Academy Sandhurst Polo Club has one of the most spectacular polo pitches in the country with the magnificent Academy buildings as a backdrop. Following the success of our inaugural Polo Afternoon when Prince Harry played for the HCR team, the Club will again have a Marquee for Members to enjoy an afternoon's polo at the RMA Sandhurst's Charity Polo Day.

The RMA Polo Club was originally formed in the 1870's by officers and cadets and started using the Academy's riding field (now the football field) for polo matches. They subsequently rented a field near Wellington College however when afternoon studies were increased, the field was considered too far away and the Polo Club closed in 1894. Resurrected in 1998, the RMA Polo Club offers Officer Cadets an introduction to polo while studying. The Club has also become the main feeder club for the Army Polo Association, part of the Combined Services Polo Association (CSPA), which is responsible for overseeing, encouraging and co-ordinating polo within the three services worldwide.

The first match is between CSPA team and Eastern Circuit United States Polo Association team for the Sudan Cup, one of three tests, for the award of The Chapple Cup. The second match is a regimental match between the King's Royal Hussars and The Household Cavalry Regiment.

TRAVELLING TO RMA SANDURST

RMA Sandhurst is located in Camberley, Surrey – approximately 30 miles from London.

By Rail

The nearest railway station is Camberley. Trains leave London Waterloo every twenty minutes with passengers changing at either Ascot (1 change) or Woking (2 changes) for Camberley. The journey time is between 1 hr 15 mins & 1 hr 30 mins.

Alternatively, passengers may travel to Blackwater railway station on the Reading-Gatwick line. Trains leave London Paddington twice an hour with passengers changing trains at Reading for Blackwater. The journey time is 55 minutes.

Both railway stations are within easy walking distance of the RMAS.

By Car

The main entrance of the Academy, the Staff College gate, is on the A30 (the London Road) opposite Camberley town centre. For Satellite Navigation systems, the postcode is GU15 4PQ.
